 Dollars, received to its full satisfaction of Cornelius Aultman the Grantee  
 hereby gives, grants bargains, sells and conveys unto the said Grantor,  
 the following described Real Estate situate in the County of Stark and  
 State of Ohio to wit: part of out lot number twenty seven in the  
 renumeration of lots in the City of Canton, in said County, bounded as  
 follows, beginning on the east line of Liberty Street, one hundred and twenty  
 four feet and 65/100 ths of a foot from the Intersection with the South line of  
 Mulberry Street thence Southwardly along the east line of Liberty Street, one  
 hundred and forty six feet and 2/10 ths of a foot, thence east sixty degrees  
 fifteen minutes east, one hundred and sixteen feet, thence north twenty  
 nine degrees forty five minutes west, seventy nine feet and five tenths of a foot  
 thence south sixty degrees fifteen minutes west fifty one feet nine inches  
 thence north twenty nine degrees forty five minutes west sixty six feet and  
 7/10 ths of a foot thence South sixty degrees fifteen minutes west sixty four feet  
 three inches, to the place of beginning, together with a right of way, six feet  
 in width along the north side of the business adjoining the above described  
 tract on the south to be used in common with the occupants of said
