



## The Canton Cutlery Works Burned.

CANTON, O., Nov. 4. — At 7:30 o'clock to-night the cutlery works of Linton Brothers were found on fire. The shop is a large frame structure and the flames gained such headway that the fire department was unable to save any portion of the building and at 9 o'clock the works were a mass of burning ruins. The shop has just been built, citizens assisting the firm, which had met with financial troubles. The firm employ about thirty skilled workmen and these are now again out of employment, after having been at work only a few weeks succeeding a year of enforced idleness. The loss is about \$15,000, while the insurance will not reach half that amount. The building was insured for \$2,500, divided equally between the Michigan fire and marine company of Detroit and the Boatman's company of Pittsburg. The fire is supposed to have started from a stove the first floor of the building.
