All and singular a Certain Tract and Piece of Land with the Appurtenances. Situate lying and being on the Waters of Ten Mile Creek Beginning at a white Oak, thence by land of said Christopher Soniticher South Eighty one and five tenth degrees West forty perches to a Post thence South Eight and a half degrees East forty perches to a post thence North Eighty one and a half degrees East forty perches to a Small white Oak thence by land of Jacob Shidler North Eight and a half degrees West forty perches to the place of Beginning Containing in the whole Ten Acres Strict measure (This a part of the same Tract of land which was Granted by

Patent unto Jacob Shidler said Patent bearing Date of fourth Day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty - six and afterward conveyed by Deed bearing Date the Twelfth Day - of September in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and - eighty six unto Christopher Soniticher said Deed Recorded in Office for Recording of Deeds in County of aforesaid in Book D folio 3 55 4)

To have and to hold the above described Tract and Piece of land - with the Appurtenances to the said Samuel Meek his Heirs and Assigns forever To the only proper use and behoof of the said Samuel Meek his Heirs and Assigns forever And the said Christopher Soniticher and Barbara his wife for themselves their Heirs and Assigns Do Hereby ~
